The resource was found using the “Google search engine by typing “KS3 UK Unit3 ICT” in the box.

Note : Finding a good resource site via this method is quite difficult because there is a lot of irrelevant results to sift through.

Ease of Use :

The site has been well planned out. Navigation is ok although if you click on the link above you need to edit the address bar to go up out of the pdf file, contents of the site are clear.

Content :

This material is clearly stated for teachers. The authors are teachers who have formed a company in Manchester covering the curriculum.

This is a good resource for making children “DO” then hoping that this has taught them something. There is not too much two way interactivity, and thought processes of “why we are doing this?” may suffer in the rush to do the activity.

Design Presentation :

The layout of the site itself is a bit scruffy but the scheme of work pdf is structured well . The pdf file is simply a document telling the teacher what he and the children should do in the lesson.

e.g place images next to text.

There are no completed examples or links of the resulting work required.
